Judges 10:10-18

(Judges 10:10) So the Israelites cried to the LORD, saying, "We have sinned against you, because we have abandoned our God and have worshiped the Baals."

(Judges 10:11) And the LORD said to the Israelites, "Did I not deliver you from the Egyptians and from the Amorites, from the Ammonites and from the Philistines?"

(Judges 10:12) The Sidonians also, and the Amalekites, and the Maonites, oppressed you; and you cried to me, and I delivered you out of their hand.

(Judges 10:13) Yet you have abandoned me and worshiped other gods; therefore I will deliver you no more.

(Judges 10:14) Go and cry to the gods whom you have chosen; let them deliver you in the time of your distress."

(Judges 10:15) And the Israelites said to the LORD, "We have sinned; do to us whatever seems good to you; but deliver us this day!"

(Judges 10:16) So they put away the foreign gods from among them and worshiped the LORD; and he could no longer bear to see Israel suffer.

(Judges 10:17) Then the Ammonites were called to arms, and they encamped in Gilead; and the Israelites came together, and they encamped at Mizpah.

(Judges 10:18) The commanders of the people of Gilead said to one another, "Who will begin the fight against the Ammonites? He shall be head over all the inhabitants of Gilead."
