## **Hebrews 3:1-6**

(Hebrews 3:1) Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession;

(Hebrews 3:2) He was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was in all His house.

(Hebrews 3:3) For He has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, by just so much as the builder of the house has more honor than the house.

(Hebrews 3:4) For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.

(Hebrews 3:5) Now Moses was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken later;

(Hebrews 3:6) but Christ was faithful as a Son over His house—whose house we are, if we hold fast our confidence and the boast of our hope firm until the end.

## Matthew 7:24-29

(Matthew 7:24) "Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock.

(Matthew 7:25) "And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded on the rock.

(Matthew 7:26) "Everyone who hears these words of Mine and does not act on them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand.

(Matthew 7:27) "The rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and it fell—and great was its fall."

(Matthew 7:28) When Jesus had finished these words, the crowds were amazed at His teaching;

(Matthew 7:29) for He was teaching them as one having authority, and not as their scribes.
