### **Psalms 33:1-12**

(Psalms 33:1) Sing joyfully to the LORD, you righteous; it is fitting for the upright to praise him.

(Psalms 33:2) Praise the LORD with the harp; make music to him on the ten-stringed lyre.

(Psalms 33:3) Sing to him a new song; play skillfully, and shout for joy.

(Psalms 33:4) For the word of the LORD is right and true; he is faithful in all he does.

(Psalms 33:5) The LORD loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of his unfailing love.

(Psalms 33:6) By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, their starry host by the breath of his mouth.

(Psalms 33:7) He gathers the waters of the sea into jars; he puts the deep into storehouses.

(Psalms 33:8) Let all the earth fear the LORD; let all the people of the world revere him.

(Psalms 33:9) For he spoke, and it came to be; he commanded, and it stood firm.

(Psalms 33:10) The LORD foils the plans of the nations; he thwarts the purposes of the peoples.

(Psalms 33:11) But the plans of the LORD stand firm forever, the purposes of his heart through all generations.

(Psalms 33:12) Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people he chose for his inheritance.
