Psalms 148:1-14

(Psalms 148:3) Praise him, sun and moon; praise him, all you shining stars!

(Psalms 148:4) Praise him, you highest heavens, and you waters above the heavens!

(Psalms 148:5) Let them praise the name of the LORD, for he commanded and they were created.

(Psalms 148:6) He established them forever and ever; he fixed their bounds, which cannot be passed.

(Psalms 148:7) Praise the LORD from the earth, you sea monsters and all deeps,

(Psalms 148:8) fire and hail, snow and frost, stormy wind fulfilling his command!

(Psalms 148:9) Mountains and all hills, fruit trees and all cedars!

(Psalms 148:10) Wild animals and all cattle, creeping things and flying birds!

(Psalms 148:11) Kings of the earth and all peoples, princes and all rulers of the earth!

(Psalms 148:12) Young men and women alike, old and young together!

(Psalms 148:13) Let them praise the name of the LORD, for his name alone is exalted; his glory is above earth and heaven.

(Psalms 148:14) He has raised up a horn for his people, praise for all his faithful, for the people of Israel who are close to him. Praise the LORD!
