(Psalms 91:1) He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.

(Psalms 91:2) I will say to the LORD, "My refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

(Psalms 91:3) For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence.

(Psalms 91:4) He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.

(Psalms 91:5) You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day,

(Psalms 91:6) nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor the destruction that wastes at noonday.

(Psalms 91:7) A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.

(Psalms 91:8) You will only look with your eyes and see the recompense of the wicked.

(Psalms 91:9) Because you have made the LORD your dwelling place—the Most High, who is my refuge—

(Psalms 91:10) no evil shall be allowed to befall you, no plague come near your tent.

(Psalms 91:11) For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

(Psalms 91:12) On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.

(Psalms 91:13) You will tread on the lion and the adder; the young lion and the serpent you will trample underfoot.

(Psalms 91:14) "Because he holds fast to me in love, I will deliver him; I will protect him, because he knows my name.

(Psalms 91:15) When he calls to me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him.

(Psalms 91:16) With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."
