Five Applications from Matthew 18:21-35

- 1. When someone repents and asks us to forgive them, we need to forgive them without keeping count of their offences.
- 2. We need to glorify and thank God for His mercy and forgiveness toward us and others.
- 3. We need to show others the mercy that God has shown to us.
- 4. The king bore the loss when he forgave the man who could not repay him. The Father and the Son bore the loss when Jesus died in our place.
- 5. Our forgiveness of others may be costly, but not as costly as our refusing to forgive can be when one comes to us and asks for mercy and forgiveness.
