International Bible Lesson Applications

1. Each day when you pray, spend some time thinking of the awesome deeds of God, which will build up your faith and inspire your praises.
2. Remember that God and those who trust in the God of the Bible have enemies. Deep down these enemies may fear God terribly, just as the demons know God exists and tremble at the thought of God.
3. As you read the Bible and learn about something God the Father or Jesus the Son have done, rejoice, praise them, and thank them; for they deserve our worship and thankfulness. Nothing is impossible with God.
4. When troubles or temptations come your way, consider them as opportunities to examine your faith and rejoice in the Lord; then, pray for the Lord Jesus to help you continue loving Him, obeying Him, and showing your faith in Him; then, others might believe and praise the Lord too.
5. Look and pray for opportunities to humbly tell others about what God has done for your soul. Your words might encourage some to keep believing and help others come to believe in the God of the Bible.
