

Week 1 - Day 1 [Genesis 1-8] Date: 12/29/14

Chapter 1 - In six days, God created everything and made it very good. Why did God create light on the first day?

Chapter 2 - God made man with the ability to make moral and intellectual choices? Why did God make woman after He had made all the animals?
