Exodus 15:1-3

(Exodus 15:1) Then Moses and the Israelites sang this song to the LORD: "I will sing to the LORD, because he has won a glorious victory; he has thrown the horses and their riders into the sea.

(Exodus 15:2) The LORD is my strong defender; he is the one who has saved me. He is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will sing about his greatness.

(Exodus 15:3) The LORD is a warrior; the LORD is his name.

Exodus 15:19

(Exodus 15:19) The Israelites walked through the sea on dry ground. But when the Egyptian chariots with their horses and drivers went into the sea, the LORD brought the water back, and it covered them."

Exodus 15:22-26

(Exodus 15:22) Then Moses led the people of Israel away from the Red Sea into the desert of Shur. For three days they walked through the desert, but found no water.

(Exodus 15:23) Then they came to a place called Marah, but the water there was so bitter that they could not drink it. That is why it was named Marah.

(Exodus 15:24) The people complained to Moses and asked, "What are we going to drink?"

(Exodus 15:25) Moses prayed earnestly to the LORD, and the LORD showed him a piece of wood, which he threw into the water; and the water became fit to drink. There the LORD gave them laws to live by, and there he also tested them.

(Exodus 15:26) He said, "If you will obey me completely by doing what I consider right and by keeping my commands, I will not punish you with any of the diseases that I brought on the Egyptians. I am the LORD, the one who heals you."
