### **Acts 2:1-16**

**(Acts 2:1)** And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

**(Acts 2:2)** And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

**(Acts 2:3)** And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

**(Acts 2:4)** And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

**(Acts 2:5)** And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

**(Acts 2:6)** Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.

**(Acts 2:7)** And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans?

**(Acts 2:8)** And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born?

**(Acts 2:9)** Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia,

**(Acts 2:10)** Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes,

**(Acts 2:11)** Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.

**(Acts 2:12)** And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this?

(Acts 2:13) Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.

(Acts 2:14) But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all *ye* that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words:

(Acts 2:15) For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is *but* the third hour of the day.

(Acts 2:16) But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel;
