Luke 24:36-53

(Luke 24:36) And as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, **Peace be unto you.**

(Luke 24:37) But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit.

(Luke 24:38) And he said unto them, **Why are ye troubled? and why do thoughts arise in your hearts?**

(Luke 24:39) **Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.**

(Luke 24:40) And when he had thus spoken, he shewed them *his* hands and *his* feet.

(Luke 24:41) And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, **Have ye here any meat?**

(Luke 24:42) And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb.

(Luke 24:43) And he took *it*, and did eat before them.

(Luke 24:44) And he said unto them, **These *are* the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and *in* the prophets, and *in* the psalms, concerning me.**

(Luke 24:45) Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

(Luke 24:46) And said unto them, **Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:**

(Luke 24:47) **And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.**

(Luke 24:48) **And ye are witnesses of these things.**

(Luke 24:49) **And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.**

(Luke 24:50) And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.

(Luke 24:51) And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.

(Luke 24:52) And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:

(Luke 24:53) And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen.
