

Study Guide on Exodus 40:16-31, 34, 38

Assign each person in the class one or more verses to study.
Each person should answer these two questions on their assigned verse.

1. What does this verse say?
2. What does this verse mean to me?
3. Discuss your answers with the class.

Exodus 40:16-31, 34, 38

(Exodus 40:16) Moses did everything just as the LORD had commanded him.

(Exodus 40:17) In the first month in the second year, on the first day of the month, the tabernacle was set up.

(Exodus 40:18) Moses set up the tabernacle; he laid its bases, and set up its frames, and put in its poles, and raised up its pillars;

(Exodus 40:19) and he spread the tent over the tabernacle, and put the covering of the tent over it; as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(Exodus 40:20) He took the covenant and put it into the ark, and put the poles on the ark, and set the mercy seat above the ark;

(Exodus 40:21) and he brought the ark into the tabernacle, and set up the curtain for screening, and screened the ark of the covenant; as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(Exodus 40:22) He put the table in the tent of meeting, on the north side of the tabernacle, outside the curtain,

(Exodus 40:23) and set the bread in order on it before the LORD; as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(Exodus 40:24) He put the lampstand in the tent of meeting, opposite the table on the south side of the tabernacle,

(Exodus 40:25) and set up the lamps before the LORD; as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(Exodus 40:26) He put the golden altar in the tent of meeting before the curtain,

(Exodus 40:27) and offered fragrant incense on it; as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(Exodus 40:28) He also put in place the screen for the entrance of the tabernacle.

(Exodus 40:29) He set the altar of burnt offering at the entrance of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting, and offered on it the burnt offering and the grain offering as the LORD had commanded Moses.

(Exodus 40:30) He set the basin between the tent of meeting and the altar, and put water in it for washing,

(Exodus 40:31) with which Moses and Aaron and his sons washed their hands and their feet.

(Exodus 40:34) Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

(Exodus 40:38) For the cloud of the LORD was on the tabernacle by day, and fire was in the cloud by night, before the eyes of all the house of Israel at each stage of their journey.
