Luke 17:11-19

(Luke 17:11) On the way to Jerusalem Jesus was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee.

(Luke 17:12) As he entered a village, ten lepers approached him. Keeping their distance,

(Luke 17:13) they called out, saying, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!”

(Luke 17:14) When he saw them, he said to them, “Go and show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were made clean.

(Luke 17:15) Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice.

(Luke 17:16) He prostrated himself at Jesus’ feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan.

(Luke 17:17) Then Jesus asked, “Were not ten made clean? But the other nine, where are they?”

(Luke 17:18) Was none of them found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?”

(Luke 17:19) Then he said to him, “Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well.”
