Others may want to send the bulletin size *International Bible Lesson* home with their students for further study in the coming week to encourage continuing Bible study. The *Study Hints for Discussion and Thinking Further* below are not actually intended to be *the answers* to the discussion questions. These indeed are "hints" a teacher may use to help students think through and discuss the questions in class. The *Class Preparation Guide* includes the questions below, and it can be given to students at the end of the previous class so they can pray, read, and think ahead to prepare for the next week's Bible class.

Questions for Discussion and Thinking Further

1. When will God's people eat the messianic feast prepared for all peoples?

After Jesus Christ returns.

2. Where can people eat a feast prepared for God's people today?

In the Church at Fellowship Dinners and in Christian homes. Spiritually as they celebrate the Lord's Supper (communion).

3. What is the shroud that enfolds all peoples and covers all nations? What will happen to it someday?

Death. Messiah Jesus has won the victory over death by His death and resurrection. He ascended into heaven and He will destroy death when He returns.

4. Who will wipe away the tears of God's people?

God the Father and Jesus the Son of God.

5. What will God's people say when Jesus returns as He promised?
