Psalms 148:1-14

(Psalms 148:1) Praise the LORD! Praise the LORD from the heavens; praise him in the heights!

(Psalms 148:2) Praise him, all his angels; praise him, all his hosts!

(Psalms 148:3) Praise him, sun and moon, praise him, all you shining stars!

(Psalms 148:4) Praise him, you highest heavens, and you waters above the heavens!

(Psalms 148:5) Let them praise the name of the LORD! For he commanded and they were created.

(Psalms 148:6) And he established them forever and ever; he gave a decree, and it shall not pass away.

(Psalms 148:7) Praise the LORD from the earth, you great sea creatures and all deeps,

(Psalms 148:8) fire and hail, snow and mist, stormy wind fulfilling his word!

(Psalms 148:9) Mountains and all hills, fruit trees and all cedars!

(Psalms 148:10) Beasts and all livestock, creeping things and flying birds!

(Psalms 148:11) Kings of the earth and all peoples, princes and all rulers of the earth!

(Psalms 148:12) Young men and maidens together, old men and children!

(Psalms 148:13) Let them praise the name of the LORD, for his name alone is exalted; his majesty is above earth and heaven.

(Psalms 148:14) He has raised up a horn for his people, praise for all his saints, for the people of Israel who are near to him. Praise the LORD!
