### **John 12:44-50 Scripture Handout New Revised Standard Version**

Assign each person in the class one or more verses to study.  
Each person should answer these two questions on their assigned verse.

1. What does this verse say?
  2. What does this verse mean to me?
- Discuss your answers with the class.

(John 12:44) Then Jesus cried aloud: “Whoever believes in me believes not in me but in him who sent me.

(John 12:45) And whoever sees me sees him who sent me.

(John 12:46) I have come as light into the world, so that everyone who believes in me should not remain in the darkness.

(John 12:47) I do not judge anyone who hears my words and does not keep them, for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

(John 12:48) The one who rejects me and does not receive my word has a judge; on the last day the word that I have spoken will serve as judge,

(John 12:49) for I have not spoken on my own, but the Father who sent me has himself given me a commandment about what to say and what to speak.

(John 12:50) And I know that his commandment is eternal life. What I speak, therefore, I speak just as the Father has told me.”
