### **John 15:10-17 Scripture Handout New American Standard Bible**

Assign each person in the class one or more verses to study.  
Each person should answer these two questions on their assigned verse.

1. What does this verse say?
  2. What does this verse mean to me?
- Discuss your answers with the class.

(John 15:10) “If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

(John 15:11) “These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full.

(John 15:12) “This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.

(John 15:13) “Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends.

(John 15:14) “You are My friends if you do what I command you.

(John 15:15) “No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.

(John 15:16) “You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

(John 15:17) “This I command you, that you love one another.”
