John 14:15-23 Scripture Handout New International Version

Each person should answer these two questions on their assigned verse.

1. What does this verse say?
 2. What does this verse mean to me?
- Discuss your answers with the class.

(John 14:15) “If you love me, keep my commands.

(John 14:16) And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever—

(John 14:17) the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

(John 14:18) I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

(John 14:19) Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.

(John 14:20) On that day you will realize that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you.

(John 14:21) Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them.”

(John 14:22) Then Judas (not Judas Iscariot) said, “But, Lord, why do you intend to show yourself to us and not to the world?”

(John 14:23) Jesus replied, “Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.”
