### **Deuteronomy 6:3-9; Matthew 19:3-9 Scripture Handout New English Version**

Assign each person in the class one or more verses to study.

(Deuteronomy 6:3) Hear therefore, O Israel, and be careful to do them, that it may go well with you, and that you may multiply greatly, as the LORD, the God of your fathers, has promised you, in a land flowing with milk and honey.

(Deuteronomy 6:4) "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.

(Deuteronomy 6:5) You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

(Deuteronomy 6:6) And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.

(Deuteronomy 6:7) You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

(Deuteronomy 6:8) You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.

(Deuteronomy 6:9) You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

(Matthew 19:3) And Pharisees came up to him and tested him by asking, "Is it lawful to divorce one's wife for any cause?"

(Matthew 19:4) He answered, "Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female,

(Matthew 19:5) and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'?

(Matthew 19:6) So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate."

(Matthew 19:7) They said to him, "Why then did Moses command one to give a certificate of divorce and to send her away?"

(Matthew 19:8) He said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart Moses allowed you to divorce your wives, but from the beginning it was not so.

(Matthew 19:9) And I say to you: whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery."
