Luke 2:15–19; John 2:1–5; 19:25–27 **Scripture Handout New English Version**

Assign each person in the class one or more verses to study.

(Luke 2:15) When the angels went away from them into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, “Let us go over to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has made known to us.”

(Luke 2:16) And they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger.

(Luke 2:17) And when they saw it, they made known the saying that had been told them concerning this child.

(John 2:1) On the third day there was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.

(John 2:2) Jesus also was invited to the wedding with his disciples.

(John 2:3) When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus said to him, “They have no wine.”

(John 2:4) And Jesus said to her, “Woman, what does this have to do with me? My hour has not yet come.”

(John 2:5) His mother said to the servants, “Do whatever he tells you.”

(John 19:25) but standing by the cross of Jesus were his mother and his mother’s sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene.

(John 19:26) When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, “Woman, behold, your son!”

(John 19:27) Then he said to the disciple, “Behold, your mother!” And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.
