Application — Five Takeaways

July 2, 2017

Exodus 3:1-12

1. It may seem to us that God takes a long time to fulfill His promises, but the 400 years of slavery followed by the Exodus show us that God will keep every one of His promises.
2. God will be with us as He prepares others and us well in advance to accomplish His good purposes.
3. God sees and hears the suffering of His people and God will comfort them and sometimes change their situation in history, just as God helped Israel in history.
4. We do not need to wait to be saved from slavery to sin and the devil. God sent Jesus Christ so we could place our faith in Him and be saved from sin and death and inherit eternal life now and forever.
5. Without needing a mountaintop experience, we can worship God in Spirit and in Truth through Jesus Christ our Lord (John 4:23-24).
