Five Applications from Luke 13:22-30

1. We should be concerned more about whether or not we are saved than about how many will be saved.
2. Jesus Christ is the narrow door that we must go to and through to enter the kingdom of God.
3. We should not be surprised if we must “make every effort,” “strive,” and “agonize,” to understand what it means to come to Jesus and then come to Him to be saved.
4. There will come a time when it will be too late to enter the kingdom of God.
5. Jesus will send away all evildoers; those who have refused to repent and follow Him into the kingdom of God.
