

# International Bible Lesson

## Five Applications from Luke 14:15-24

1. When Jesus was teaching, He was inviting His listeners to the feast in the kingdom of God.
2. When people are reading and studying the Bible, especially the New Testament, Jesus is inviting them to the feast in the kingdom of God.
3. Some will make excuses for not accepting Jesus' invitation, for not believing in Him, and for not following Him into the kingdom of God.
4. Those who refuse Jesus' invitation will not enter the kingdom of God.
5. Jesus is not prejudiced, and He invites all to come to Him: no one is too poor, crippled, blind or lame to come to Him and enter the kingdom of God.
