## International Bible Lesson Five Applications from Deuteronomy 6:1-9

- 1. Some of the statutes and rules given to the Israelites were intended specifically for life in the Promised Land, the land flowing with milk and honey.
- 2. The commandment to love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might is intended for everyone everywhere to obey.
- 3. As believers, it will go well with us if we carefully obey the LORD's commands, but that does not mean that we will not suffer or be persecuted.
- 4. When we write the LORD's commandments on our hearts, we fully intend to obey the LORD's commandments.
- 5. Believers in the Bible should teach the Bible by word and example to their children at every opportunity throughout the day and into the night.
