Five Applications from Deuteronomy 6:1-9

1. Some of the statutes and rules given to the Israelites were intended specifically for life in the Promised Land, the land flowing with milk and honey.
2. The commandment to love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might is intended for everyone everywhere to obey.
3. As believers, it will go well with us if we carefully obey the LORD's commands, but that does not mean that we will not suffer or be persecuted.
4. When we write the LORD's commandments on our hearts, we fully intend to obey the LORD's commandments.
5. Believers in the Bible should teach the Bible by word and example to their children at every opportunity throughout the day and into the night.
