

Mark 1:16-20 and Luke 14:25-33

International Bible Lesson Applications

1. Jesus can use what we have learned in the past; such as the ability to fish, to make us even better disciples of Jesus and helpers of others.
2. Jesus' disciples must be willing to leave what they are doing to follow Him wherever He leads them.
3. A disciple of Jesus may face possible suffering and death to remain a true disciple of Him.
4. Before someone becomes a disciple of Jesus, they should count the cost and decide whether they are willing to pay the possible price.
5. To become a disciple of Jesus, a person must renounce all they have and love Jesus more than anyone or anything else—even more than themselves.
