

Mark 14:17-25 & Hebrews 8:6-13

International Bible Lesson Applications

1. The consequences of accepting or rejecting Jesus as Lord and Savior are so important and serious that Jesus said it would have been better for Judas if he had never been born.
2. Jesus mediates a better and more excellent covenant for those who believe in Him because it fulfills better promises than the old covenant.
3. When we trust in Jesus as our Lord and Savior, He puts the laws of God into our minds and we will obey His commandments (see also John 14:15 & John 15:10).
4. When we trust in Jesus as our Lord and Savior, He writes the laws of God on our hearts, so we strongly desire to obey God in everything and pray for His help to do God's will (see also Matthew 6:9-10).
5. When we trust in Jesus as our Lord and Savior, He will be merciful toward our iniquities and no longer remember our sins (see also Matthew 26:28 & Luke 24:46-49).
