- 1. Ruth's history illustrates the truth of Romans 8:28 "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose."
- 2. When God's people obey God's Law in the Bible, the Law of Love, they will meet the needs of one another.
- 3. Even the most unlikely people can come to know, trust, love, and obey God and be welcomed among God's people.
- 4. God's people should treat others with the same gentleness, grace, and mercy that they would use when caring for members of their own family.
- 5. When God's people work hard, care for, and help others they demonstrate their faith, loyalty, and virtuous life to believers and unbelievers—leading some to a deeper trust in God.
