International Bible Lesson Applications

1. Ruth's history illustrates the truth of Romans 8:28 — “We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose.”
2. When God's people obey God's Law in the Bible, the Law of Love, they will meet the needs of one another.
3. Even the most unlikely people can come to know, trust, love, and obey God and be welcomed among God's people.
4. God's people should treat others with the same gentleness, grace, and mercy that they would use when caring for members of their own family.
5. When God's people work hard, care for, and help others they demonstrate their faith, loyalty, and virtuous life to believers and unbelievers—leading some to a deeper trust in God.
