John 5:1-9 Application

1. Jesus always went where He could do the most good. For examples, to a Samaritan woman and her town, to Cana where He could heal the son of a royal official, and to a pool where He could heal a man with a long-term illness. We can pray for God's guidance and help to do the most good.
2. Jesus went as a doctor to heal the sick, but more than physical healing, Jesus wanted the sick to receive Him as their Savior and accept the gift of eternal life from Him. We can pray that what we say and do will help people learn more about Jesus and what He offers all who will believe in Him.
3. Jesus wants to meet people's physical, moral, and spiritual needs, not just physical. We can tell people about Jesus no matter what their needs.
4. Jesus wants people to have faith in Him and His ability to do whatever He chooses to do to help people in need. Jesus is totally dependable.
5. Jesus can do whatever He chooses and does not depend on the faith of anyone else to achieve His purposes. We depend on Jesus for everything.
