John 5:30-38 Application

1. We can judge more justly if we follow Jesus' example and do not seek our own will; but instead, seek the will of God revealed in the Bible and through Jesus.
2. If someone gives testimony about themselves, but no one else we know as trustworthy agrees, then we need to be careful so as not to be misled.
3. John the Baptist was known as a truthful prophet, and John's testimony about Jesus and Jesus' testimony about himself agreed.
4. Jesus accepted human testimonies for our sake, not His, that we might believe Him, receive Him, and be saved.
5. If the word of God in the Bible does not abide in us, or dwell and remain in us, we do not believe the truth of the Bible and the true words of and the truth about Jesus. Today, some are like the religious leaders in Jesus' day.
