Romans 11:11-24 Application

1. The sins of some help others come to saving faith in Jesus Christ, but that does not mean that a Christian should sin to help someone come to faith.
2. Coming to saving faith in Jesus Christ can be compared to receiving riches, which the adopted children of God truly receive and keep forever.
3. Christians become a part of spiritual Israel when they accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.
4. The revelations, teachings, laws, and promises in the Bible are used by the Holy Spirit to help and support Christians (like a root supports the branches of a tree) with the nourishment they need to come to faith in Jesus Christ and remain faithful to Jesus through their trials and troubles.
5. No one needs to persist in unbelief. If someone stumbles away from faithful obedience to God, through faith in Jesus Christ they can return to God and God in His kindness can restore them to faithful obedience.
